Burnet Moth – Feeding and mating on airfield.

Robins – Feeding and mating in Rollaston Park Road.

Colard Doves – Feeding and mating in Rollaston Park Road.

Pigeons - Feeding and mating in Rollaston Park Road.

Peacock Butterfly - Feeding in Rollaston Park Road.
